

Provenance of Silver Table Service

- American repousse silver table service, by George B. Sharp for Bailey & Company, Philadelphia, circa 1848-1850
- Set consists of:
 1. Hot water urn, height: 16 inches, weight 100 oz.
 2. Coffee pot, height: 11-3/4 inches, weight 44 oz.
 3. Teapot, height: 9-1/2 inches, weight 40 oz.
 4. Covered sugar, height: 8-3/4 inches, weight 25 oz.
 5. Waste bowl, depth: 6-1/4 inches, weight 16 oz.
 6. Cream jug, height: 8 inches, weight 17 oz.
 7. Milk jug, height: 10 inches, weight 22 oz.
 8. Milk jug, height: 11 inches, weight 31 oz.
 9. Pair water pitchers, each height: 10-3/4 inches
Weight on one, 32 oz.
Weight on the other 33 oz.
- Each with repousse scenes and C-scroll cartouche enclosing a monogram FTHF; the lids with seated Oriental figures
