



Tadeusz Cybulski, Polish artist 1878–1954 Krakow





Tadeusz Cybulski, after obtaining a doctorate in law at the Jagiellonian University, studied sculpture at the Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków in 1905-10 with K. Laszczka, painting in 1918-20 with W. Weiss, and studied abroad in 1914 in at the Viennese Academy with E. Gerisch and in 1924-25 at the Paris branch of the Academy of Fine Arts in Kraków with J. Pankiewicz. As a painter, he was associated with the Unicorn Guild of Visual Artists (active from 1926), Zwornik Visual Artists Association (active in 1919-30), ZZPAP and TPSP in Krakow, with whom he constantly exhibited his works. In addition, he presented his paintings at exhibitions

IPS and abroad he took part in exhibitions organized by TOSSPO. He painted portrait studies, landscapes and still lifes. In addition, he was also involved in sculpture, set design, designing theater costumes, teaching and literary criticism. He was also a musician.
